LONG TERM VISION

- TO EQUIP 2 SCHOOLS IN NEPAL WITH THE RESOURCES TO TEACH BASIC INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY (IT) TO THE 10+ AGE GROUP AS A CORE CURRICULA SUBJECT

THE SCHOOLS

- LOCATED IN THE HIMALAYAN FOOTHILLS 4HRS DRIVE FROM KATHMANDU
- 900 PUPILS IN TOTAL WITH ~80 IN 10+AGE GROUP
- LOCAL ROTARY CLUBS ALREADY ACTIVELY SUPPORT



STAGE 1 OF THE VISION

- EQUIP THE SCHOOLS WITH ~6 LAPTOPS (PRE LOADED WITH SOFTWARE FOR BASIC IT)
- TRAIN SELECTED TEACHERS AS THE 'TRAINERS' IN BASIC IT (WINDOWS, WORD, EXCEL)

ENABLING STEPS

- FORM A TEAM OF ~6 ROTARIANS FROM BRIGANTES AND OTHER CLUBS
- RAISE FUNDS FOR THE PURCHASE OF LAPTOPS AND IT TRAINING MANUALS (~ £2K TO £3K) THROUGH A MIXTURE OF CORPORATE APPROACHES, CLUB EVENTS AND PERSONAL EFFORTS
- DECIDE VISIT DATE (either Sept/October 2010 or February/March 2011)
- UNDERGO INDUCTION TRAINING WITH THE PROVIDERS OF THE TRAINING MANUALS PACKAGE
